Important Dates:

- Register to vote by: Fri Oct 9
- Early Voting period: Oct 15 - Oct 31
- Request absentee by mail ballot by: Tues Oct 27
- Election day: Tues Nov 3
- Return absentee mail in ballots by: Tues Nov 3 by 5pm; must contain postmark on/before that day

 - Scroll down to “Voter Registration Application” and click on “Submit a Voter Registration Application”
 - Enter NC DMV driver’s license # AND Social Security Number AND Date of Birth
 - If you have these available, continue with automated system or click “Download Voter Registration Application”
 - If you do not have these ID numbers on hand, click “Download Voter Registration Application” - new window will open with application - complete, print, sign & turn in to Haywood County Board of Elections*
