- Accepting original art, articles, essays, poems, reflections, short stories, and creative anomalies.
- We also accept book reviews on books related to the theme (best if they're in the Grace library!) and poetry reviews.
- We're looking for writings about spirituality, experiences with God, grace, and Grace Church.
- Submission limit per person: three pieces per issue
- People welcome to submit: Friends of Grace, Grace members
- Poetry reviews - Submit a published poem that relates to the theme and write at least 200 words about how it connects to the theme/why it's significant. Must include the poet's name and original publication date.

Deadline and Theme: May 31, 2024, is the deadline for the first edition focusing on the theme “Seeking” as it relates to the Mission Statement of Grace Church in the Mountains

Art: black and white only (except cover), submit in PDF, .png or .jpg format.

Prose word limit (articles, reflections, reviews, etc.) - 1,500 words or less

Poetry limit: 50 lines or less
